

## NCE N-Channel Super Trench Power MOSFET

### Description


The NCEP02T10T uses **Super Trench** technology that is uniquely optimized to provide the most efficient high frequency switching performance. Both conduction and switching power losses are minimized due to an extremely low combination of  $R_{DS(ON)}$  and  $Q_g$ . This device is ideal for high-frequency switching and synchronous rectification.




**1)  $E_{AS}$  test Circuit**




**2) Gate charge test Circuit**




**3) Switch Time Test Circuit**






**Figure 1 Output Characteristics**




**Figure 2 Transfer Characteristics**




**Figure 3  $R_{DS(on)}$ - Drain Current**




**Figure 4  $R_{DS(on)}$ -Junction Temperature**




**Figure 5 Gate Charge**




**Figure 6 Source- Drain Diode Forward**




Vds Drain-Source Voltage (V)  
**Figure 7 Capacitance vs Vds**




TA-Junction Temperature(°C)

**Figure 8 Safe Operation Area**




TA-Junction Temperature (°C)
